Preparation for Competition, Consumer Choice & Consumer Trust Review (CCT)

⊙ IAG-CCT formed to discuss 70 GNSO- and ALACrecommended metrics

- ⊙ Interim recommendation approved March 2013 for consumer survey and economic study
- ⊙ Final report under Board consideration
- Recommends data collection for several additional metrics



Preparation for CCT Review – Consumer Survey

- Global survey to assess perceptions of consumer trust and consumer choice
- ⊙ Design phase of survey <u>completed</u>
 - ⊙ Survey fielding underway
- ⊙ Follow-on survey to take place one year later
- Upcoming milestones:
 - ⊙ Completion of survey phase Q1 2015
 - Baseline data available Q2 2015




Preparation for CCT Review – *Economic Study*

- Economic study of <u>pricing</u>, innovation, and marketing practices in new gTLDs
- ⊙ Contracting with a qualified provider in process
- Study targeted to begin in Q1 2015
- ⊙ Follow-on study to take place one year later
- Registry/registrar input on metrics related to economic study requested
 - Data to be provided directly to selected firm and will be aggregated and anonymized
- Upcoming milestones:
 - ⊙ Baseline draft by Q2 2015

AoC Process Improvements

Process Improvements for next cycle

- Use volunteer time and ICANN resources more efficiently
- Add predictability and consistency to stakeholder participation and feedback
- Allocate more time for planning within each phase of the review
- Facilitate interaction between all parties to result in feasible and implementable recommendations delivered on schedule and within budget

Examples

- Publication of anticipated schedule, time commitment in the call for volunteers.
- Timely Staff updates on progress of recommendation implementation
- Clearly articulated review budget and rationale available at the start of the review
- Early engagement between the Review Team and ICANN leadership to address scope, issues and dependencies impacting the review
- ✓ Project management discipline

Organizational Reviews

Overview of Organizational Reviews

Objective

- Comply with requirements of ICANN Bylaws examine organizational effectiveness
- Apply lessons learned from prior reviews

Independent Examiner

- Selected by competitive bid, based on set criteria
- Tightly scoped contract

Working Party

- Designated by the organization under review
- Serves as a liaison between the SIC, the organization under review, ICANN Stakeholders and Examiner

Work Methods


- Examine documentation, records, reports; observe
- 360 Assessment online tool
- Limited Interviews

Review Criteria

Objective and quantifiable, selected from developed lists




Organizational Review Cycle – 5 Years



ICANN

Organizational Reviews Process Improvements

- Planning phase of 6 months, including clear scope of work and deliverables defined early in the competitive bidding process
- Review Working Party appointed by the structure under review to serve as a liaison between the independent examiner, staff, the SIC and the structure
- Early and continuous engagement of the Working Party with the independent examiner
- Robust outreach to ensure broad and diverse participation in the review
