



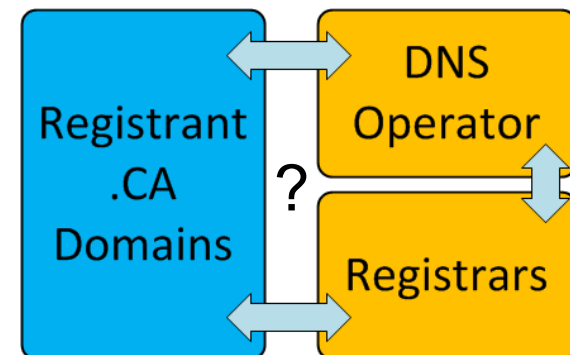

The DNS Operators – New in DNSSEC

- **DNS Operator is the entity operating the DNS servers & configuration for the domain**
- In some instances, the DNS Operator is;
 - The Registrant (operate their own DNS)
 - The Registrar on behalf of Registrant
 - The Web hosting provider on behalf of Registrant or Registrar
 - An external DNS Operator on behalf of Registrant or Registrar
- With DNSSEC, the transfer of DNS Operator along a domain transfer is complex and not well defined.
